Good afternoon Nashoba Tech Community,

I would like to remind everyone as the end of the school year draws near of the importance of Safe Driving. Between Memorial Day and Labor Day, vehicle traffic is significantly increased with High School and College students' home for the summer. Hence, the 100 deadliest days of driving for teens.

According to AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety studies, more than 10 people per day will die this summer in a car crash involving a teen driver. New drivers have a lot going against them: A lack of experience, teen courage, and a false sense of security with new vehicle safety enhancements.

Distractions also play an important role. Whether it's a loud radio, talking to passengers, eating or drinking while driving all can play a significant part in not focusing on the road. Which leads me to the use of cell phones.

- Cells Phones are PROHIBITED while driving for anyone under the age of 18.

Please tell your son or daughter that if they feel *they must* use their cell phone, to pull over to a safe location, put the vehicle in park and then make a call or text. It is not worth risking your life or the life of another because of poor decision making. Additionally, always be aware of your surroundings. With the warmer weather upon us, there is an increase of bicyclists and pedestrians on the side of the roadways, please be aware of them so you don't regret something horrible for the rest of your life. Remember, "IT CAN WAIT".

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts, at this time, has a bill in Legislation which looks favorably to pass soon that will be having Massachusetts going Hands Free. This means that cell phone use for everyone, teens and adults, will be prohibited while driving. Parents, please talk your children about Safe Driving, cell phones, seat belts, distractions inside the vehicle, and for many, Junior Operator License restrictions.
